About Autography

This project believes that everyone on the autism spectrum has the right to feel happy. Autography will host a weekly group workshop and a weekly open-access session at Photofusion where participants will work with professional teachers, ASC experts, mentors and artists on the following:

- Establishing a supportive peer group through weekly meetings with fellow ASC adults in an accessible and non-judgmental space.
- Learning new skills and techniques for managing elements of our conditions including self-care and well-being skills.
- Working together to make photographic work that will help us and the public understand our unique experiences of ASC.
- Working together to programme an ASC awareness festival at Photofusion for members of the public to come and gain a greater awareness of ASC conditions.

Duties and Responsibilities

Plan and present photography activities through workshops and classes in a non-judgmental, non-directive and supportive manner, adapting to the individual needs of the participants.

Support and mentor Anna with her development within the programme.

Initiate and maintain ongoing communication with appropriate project staff.

Attend staff meetings and in-service trainings.
